In the text within the GfA it says "be nationals of Serbia and be located in one of the 22 cities and municipalities which touch or span the Danube river" What does "located" mean?	The location is determined based on the: registration of the business premises including branch offices, or the area of operations, or the area of responsibility.
Q2	Is it possible that National Employment Service is an applicant in the project?	As stated under point 2.1.1 of the GfA accompanied by the Corrigendum No.1, in the interest of equal treatment of applicants, the Contracting Authority cannot give a prior opinion on the eligibility of an applicant, a partner, an action or specific activities. Q 14	What is the maximum size of one project?	Any grant requested under this Call for Proposals must fall between the following minimum and maximum amounts:
		minimum amount: EUR 100,000
		maximum amount: EUR 300,000
		Any grant requested under this Call for Proposals must fall between the following minimum and maximum percentages of total eligible costs of the action:
		• Minimum percentage: 50% of the total estimated eligible costs of the action.
		• Maximum percentage: 90% of the total eligible costs of the action (see also Section 2.1.4 of the GfA).
		The balance (i.e. the difference between the total cost of the action and the amount requested from the Contracting Authority) must be financed from the applicant's or partners' own resources, or from sources other than the European Union budget or the European Development Fund.

Q 16	Can we include partners from Croatia?	Partners must satisfy the eligibility criteria as applicable on the grant beneficiary himself except that they may be located in any of the cities and municipalities belonging to the 'Danube-Serbia districts''.
Q 17	Why is the Municipality of Backi Petrovac not highlighted in light blue as other municipalities that directly border with the Danube river?	A Corrigendum has been made.
Q 18	Will PADOR be used?	Since the Contracting Authority is the Austrian Development Agency, PADOR will not be used.
Q 19	Will there be an official translation of the Guidelines for Applicants?	GfA for Applicants are published in English language.
