Key findings after desk phase

☐ Need for flexibility in programming approach **Definition of sectors** □ DEVCO experience of SWAp ☐ Lessons learned from IPA Components III-V ☐ The need to establish a multi-annual perspective ☐ The identification and formulation phases (the need for better templates ...) ☐ Lack of necessary conditions for consistent programming ☐ Need for guidance and training for beneficiary institutions





Main conditions for sector programming

☐ Sector has accession relevance and identified as priority in strategic documents (Country Strategy Paper ...) ☐ Predictable multi-annual funding from State budget (3 years ...) ☐ Identification of a Line Ministry which is responsible for sector and develops the process ☐ Monitoring is in place and operational





Possible implications of sector approach

- ☐ The role of NIPACs may change ☐ The beneficiaries will need more
- ☐ The beneficiaries will need more time to prepare adequate multi-annual Sector Policy Documents
- ☐ The absorption capacity of lead ministries should be strengthened
- ☐ The main conditions for sector approach may not to be in place by 2014
- ☐ The role of EUD may change
