SEE 2020 Headline targets

- To increase Governance effectiveness
- Supporting PA capacities to design and implement development policies
- Finding complementarities and synergies with other regional initiatives/institutions, e.g. WBIF or WB-Regional Competitiveness Initiative
- Promoting effective implementation of legislation, governing competition, improving judiciary capacities, enforcing rule of law, anti-corruption measures
- Responsible fiscal and monetary policy

Which sector strategies would need to be deployed to contribute achieving the targets in the area of Governance growth as defined in the SEE 2020 Vision?

- anti-corruption, judiciary, fight against organised crime, Public administration reform, civil society development, policy design and coordination, Public Procurement, Public private partnership, statistics

Which other, complementary targets should be considered relevant?

- Regulatory quality
- Business environment e.g. *red tape*
- Investment

2. Which common issues/problems/challenges have to be addressed in the area of Governance growth?

- enhancing traditional PA reform with Economic Governance notion
- diversification of the key institutional partners
- definition and acceptance of quantifiable indicators for progress evaluation, recognised internationally
- lack of reliable M&E methodologies and procedures in place

3. What measures need to be taken at national/horizontal/regional level to tackle the above mentioned common issues and to reach the targets?

Most of the measures should be dealt with at National level while complementarity should be achieved with Regional intervention

- Economic Governance promotion
- Indicators standard setting
- Comparative data and M&E tools

Who provides what kind of support (donors/IFIs) and where is IPA support most important?

- MB IPA: ensuring integral approach (Government + Economic Governance) in development of National strategy documents for growth
- MB IPA: comparable indicators, Monitoring and Evaluation system
